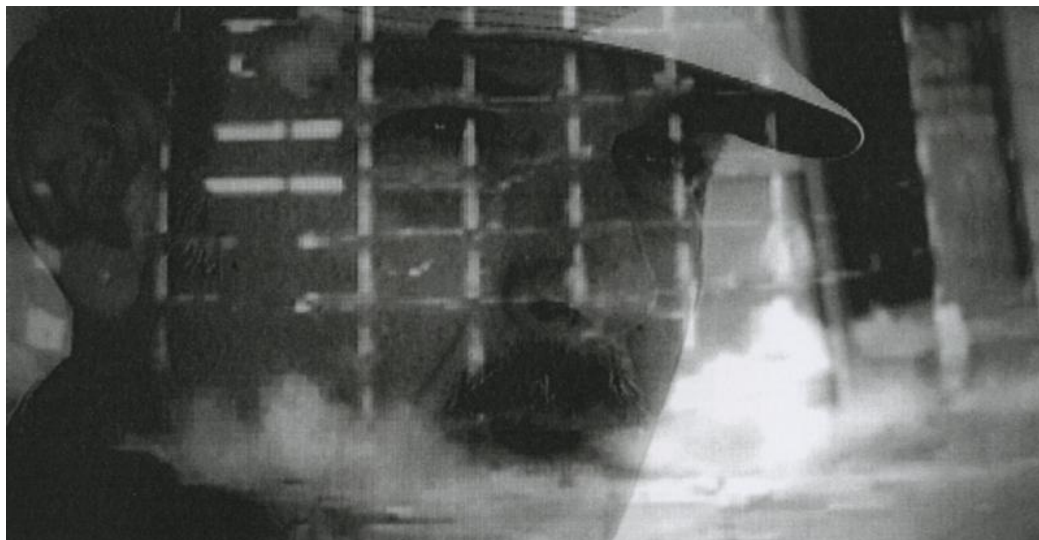


Tómas Gislason, Denmark, 1997

The director Tómas Gislason went to USA to make Road TV about his own experience of The Land of God in a period where several events took place: the O.J. In a state of fear, paranoia and edged world images Tómas is moving around between militia people, black and white racists, TV-commentators and priests trying to find his own point of view.
