In the big city he becomes friends with street kids. To survive in the cold weather Miga has to sleep with his new friends in the city sewers. His friends try to help him in the search for his missing sister, but they have to be careful not to be caught by the police.

Street kids from Mongolia's capital Ulaan Baatar play themselves in this dramatised documentary.
