Elise is a glamorous small town mystery woman who lives in close enough contact, physical and otherwise, with a doctor, a vicar and a military man, only one of them her husband. When a suicide occurs, a series of flashbacks, spanning the years 1928-47, serve to shed light on the various relationships, but who is Elise really: a goddess of eroticism? A femme fatale? A devoted mother and wife? A free woman forerunner?
