



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
THE HOUSE THAT JACK BUILT / THE HOUSE THAT JACK BUILT

USA in the 1970s. We follow the highly intelligent Jack over an span of 12 years and are introduced to the murders that define Jack's development as a serial killer. We experience the story from Jack's point of view, while he postulates each murder is an artwork in itself. As the inevitable police intervention is drawing nearer, he is taking greater and greater risks in his attempt to create the ultimate artwork. Along the way we experience Jack's descriptions of his personal condition, problems and thoughts through a recurring conversation with the unknown Verge - a grotesque mixture of sophistry mixed with an almost childlike self-pity and psychopathic explanations. The film is a dark and sinister story, yet presented through a philosophical and even occasional humorous tale.

LAND OF MINE / UNDER SANDET Taking place in May 1945 only a few days after the end of the war, the film tells the story of how a group of German prisoners of war were brought to Denmark and forced to disarm the two million landmines that had been scattered along the West Coast by the German occupying forces. In charge of the enfeebled young men performing the dangerous task is Sergeant Carl Leopold Rasmussen. Like so many of his fellow Danes, he has a deep hatred for the Germans after having suffered five years of hardships during the occupation. He lets his rage rain down on the prisoners, until one day a tragic incident makes him change his view of the enemy even if it may be too late.

Land of Mine has been in high demand on the festival circuit since its debut at Toronto. Roland Møller, who plays the sergeant, and Louis Hofmann, one of the German boys, shared a Best Actor award at Tokyo, while the film was awarded an Audience prize in Gijon. The film made its US premiere at Sundance. Zandvliet's feature debut *Applause* (2009) won two awards at Karlovy Vary and was selected for Toronto.

From the outside, Rosa and Frederik are the perfect couple. Rosa is successful, deliberate and analytical, while Frederik complements her by being her opposite, succeeding in life thanks to his undeniable charm. But something is wrong! When Rosa gets pregnant, after secretly having gone off the pill, Frederik convinces her to get an abortion. Meanwhile, Frederik is having an affair with Sonja, who is more in love with him than he is in her. Sonja gets pregnant as well and seeks clarity about what to do at the city's best psychologist - Rosa. Should she keep the baby, have an abortion, involve her lover? As Sonja incidentally reveals the identity of the father, Rosa's world collapses, and "the perfect couple" finds themselves in the midst of their first crisis, having to re-evaluate everything.

Love and other Catastrophes is Sofie Stougaard's feature debut, which she also wrote. Stougaard has a long acting career behind her.

Insects as food is a hot topic. Particularly over the last few years, since the UN recommended edible insects as a resource to combat world hunger, they have been heralded for their taste by cooks and gastronomes, for their low ecological impact by environmentalists and for their nutritional content by public health scientists. It would seem that insects are the new superfood that will fix our problems of global food security. In the past three years a team from Copenhagen-based Nordic Food Lab made up of chefs and researchers Josh Evans, Ben Reade and Roberto Flore have been travelling the world to hear what some of the two billion people who already eat insects have to say.

The film premiered at Tribeca Film Festival and has had a busy festival life with screenings among others at Cineambiente in Torino, where it won an award, Edinburgh, Durban, Melbourne, Prizren and Hong Kong. Drawn by the glamor and easy riches of China's historic real estate boom, she opens a foreigner rental agency designed to help Chinese real estate developers market their new developments. But this business takes a dubious turn as her foreigners are increasingly used in a surreal effort to turn remote rural ghost towns into "globalized booming cities" on the days that outside investors and political leaders visit. When the inevitable happens and the real estate bubble starts to pop, Yana is forced to sell her company and reassess everything she ever believed in.

American director and anthropologist David Borenstein started making *Dream Empire* while in China doing a PhD on the country's housing boom. In March 2011, radio host Obaidah Zytoon and her circle of friends join the street protests against President Bashar al-Assad, as the Arab Spring reaches Syria. Knowing their country would be changed forever, this group of artists and activists begin filming their lives and the events around them. But as the regime's violent response spirals the country into a bloody civil war, their hopes for a better future will be tested by violence, imprisonment and death. Obaidah leaves Damascus and journeys around the country, from her hometown of Zabadani, to the center of the rebellion in Homs, and to northern Syria where she witnesses the rise of extremism. A deeply personal road movie, the film captures the fate of Svria through the intimate lens of a small circle of friends.

The War Show opens Venice Days and is selected for Toronto 2016. Dalsgaard debuted as documentary director with Afghan Muscles (2007), winner of Best Director at the AFI Fest in Los Angeles, and has since released Bogota Change (2009), The Human Scale (2012), Travelling with Mr. T (2012) and Life is Sacred (2015).
