BEFORE IT ENDS / BEFRIELSEN


When a boarding school for young adults is turned into an internment camp for German refugees during the final months of World War II, the headmaster couple Jakob and Lis and their children are thrust into an impossible situation. Should the family help the refugees - or stand firm in the Danish resistance against the Germans?

BEFORE IT ENDS is inspired by true events and depicts a sensitive chapter in the history of Denmark: The handling of 250,000 German civil refugees who came to Denmark in the spring of 1945. The feature is a drama about a family under pressure and the limits of charity.

Writer/director Anders Walter kickstarted his career by winning an Academy Award for the short film 'Helium' in 2014. After this he directed the American feature film 'I Kill Giants' (2017). Walter has both written and directed 'BEFORE IT ENDS', which is his first Danish feature. The main character is played by Danish actor Pilou Asbæk, known internationally for his role in 'Game of Thrones', and the oscar nominated feature 'A War'.

THE BASTARD / BASTARDEN

In the mid-1700s, Danish King Frederik V declared that the wild heath of Jutland should be tamed, cultivated, and colonized so that civilization could spread and new taxes be generated for the royal house. However, no one dared to follow the King's decree. The heath meant certain death – a godforsaken place haunted by ravenous wolves, highwaymen, and a brutal and unforgiving nature. But in the late summer of 1755, a lone soldier by the name of Ludvig Kahlen rode into the heath in a stubborn pursuit of a lifelong dream, determined to reach his goal: The heath would either bring him the wealth and honour he had long seeked... or get the better of him.

Writer-director Nikolaj Arcel collaborates with scriptwriter Anders Thomas Jensen ('Riders of Justice') on his first Danish language film since his Berlin-winning and Oscar-nominated 'A Royal Affair'. Mads Mikkelsen stars alongside Amanda Collin, Kristine Kujath Thorp and Gustav Lindh. Arcel graduated from The National Film School of Denmark in 2001 and apart from directing his own films, he has written scripts for some of biggest local box-office hits in recent years.



Michael Noer made his feature film debut with the prison drama 'R' (2010), co-directed with Tobias Lindholm. The film won top awards at Göteborg and Mumbai as well as several national film awards. Additionally Noer also directed 'Northwest' (2013), 'Key House Mirror' (2015) as well as the international remake of 'Papillon' (2017) and 'Before the Frost' (2019), both selected for Toronto Film Festival.

Tobias is not used to receiving love and attention from home, so the unfamiliar affection Aron offers is difficult for him to handle. Every time Aron gets close, Tobias pushes him away.

A young woman has disappeared without a trace. Three months later her boyfriend agrees to an unusual arrangement: to be locked in an apartment and interrogated by the woman's father. It soon becomes obvious that even long before her disappearance, the two lovers had chosen a strange and unconventional life: cut off from the world, isolated in the middle of the big city.

Skovbjerg made his debut with 'Sticks and Stones', which premiered at London Film Festival in 2018 and won a prize at the Danish Robert Awards. He became a prominent voice among the young generation with his two youth series 'Anton90' and 'Fastland'.

The film is based on the Norwegian novel 'Sander' by Terje Holtet. The screenplay is written by Eskil Vogt, who came to prominence with his collaboration with Joachim Trier.


EMPIRE / VIFTEN

The Danish West Indies, 1848. Anna and Petrine have had a sister-like friendship for years. They are both women of colour living within the Danish colonial system, but Petrine is an enslaved housekeeper and Anna is her owner. Anna is free and shares her life with the white Danish Governor General. She has made a fortune trading enslaved people while at the same time encouraging better conditions for the enslaved. Petrine wants to buy her own freedom but fears hurting Anna, as rumours of a slave riot threaten Anna's privileged position in Danish society. As with everything in this story, nothing is just black or white.

Empire is a non-traditional period piece about Denmark's relatively unknown colonial past, written by Danish-Nigerian Anna Neye and directed by Frederikke Aspöck. Like the director's previous three features, Empire examines the extreme complexity of individual characters. Her most recent film, the prison comedy-drama 'Out Of Tune' (2019), premiered in Rotterdam and became a national box-office hit.

THE IDIOT / IDIOTEN

Tobias and Cille are lovers with a trouble past, determined to turn their lives around. Tobias is out of rehab and Cille is slowly getting back to a normal life after years of mental and physical illness. The young couple is now expecting their first child, but despite the happy circumstances, their unfortunate past seem to cling to them. During a rehabilitation course, Tobias discovers that he wants to become an actor. However, people around him do not approve of his newfound joy and neither does social services, who are more than familiar with Tobias and Cille. They start questioning if the young couple is at all fit for parenthood.

Writer-director Kasper Rune made his feature debut with the no-budget movie 'Denmark', which screened in Generation 14Plus at the Berlinale in 2018. THE IDIOT is inspired by the director's and his actors' own upbringing, life and experiences, which form the basis for the direction and the improvised acting. The main character is played by writer-musician Jacob Skyggebjerg who made his acting debut in 'Denmark'.

During a lonely summer vacation, the introverted Little Allan is talked into acting as a human antenna for his old, UFO-obsessed neighbour. An invasion fleet is coming, and apparently the only way to save Earth is by communicating through Little Allan's brainwaves. But what they find is not exactly an invasion fleet. When the rickety antenna construction collapses, Little Allan is only barely saved by the alien girl, Britney, who is doing a school project about the primitive human race. Now Little Allan has to help her get home, while she becomes fascinated with this little specimen of the human species: Why does this boy keep saying that he is fine, even though his parents just got divorced, and he's clearly not? Is that how all little humans work?

Amalie Næsby Fick graduated as an animation director from the National Film School of Denmark in 2016. She made her debut as feature director with 'The Incredible Story of the Giant Pear' (2017), which premiered at the Berlinale, and she made her serial debut with 'Sex' (2020), also selected for Berlin.

THE QUIET MIGRATION / STILLE LIV

The young man, Carl, lives a quiet life in the countryside with his adoptive parents. His destiny is predetermined as he is the only son and he is expected to take over his parents' farm and carry on the family's proud farming traditions. It has been this way for generations and with Carl's help it will continue. But Carl doesn't fit in, he knows he can't fulfil his parents' dream. He wants something different. As an adopted child from South Korea, Carl carries a secret longing and a wish to find his own place and his roots. Torn between two worlds, Carl must make a choice about where he belongs. The film revolves around the 'ties of blood' and 'belonging and not belonging' as adoptees try to find themselves and their place in the adoptive family.

Malene Choi's feature-length debut 'The Return', also dealing with transnational adoption, premiered and received a Special Mention in Rotterdam in 2018 and went on to numerous other festivals including Gothenburg, CPH:DOX and Toronto Hot Docs. 
SUPERPOSITION / SUPERPOSITION

The creative couple Stine and Teit and their young son Nemo leave their urban life in Copenhagen behind in favour of an isolated forest in Sweden, where they hope to find themselves as individuals while documenting their new lifestyle in an ongoing podcast series. Regretfully, they realize there's another couple across the lake, which is surprisingly alike themselves. Soon, old grudges and selfish desires begin to take over, forcing them to confront their own egos.

The psychological thriller deals with the fundamental split between self realisation and being present in life. Most of us have immense ambitions for our lives and self-expression, as well as for our happiness and our partner. SUPERPOSITION sheds a light on the modern day relationship and investigates whether we are in fact too self-absorbed to be together.

In 1963 in a flat in Copenhagen one of Denmark's most acclaimed writers, Tove Ditlevsen, lives with her husband, editor-in-chief Victor Andreasen. Her talent is indisputable, only her husband's destructive envy surpasses it. In her writing she gives voice to suppressed women, providing them with courage to leave behind husbands and the patriarchal structures of society. 
VIKTOR VS. THE WORLD / VIKTOR MOD VERDEN

Luckily, it turns out that Viktor has a hidden talent for insurance because of everything his mother has told him about fear, and his father tries to take advantage of this. In the process Viktor meets Josefine, an incredibly unlucky middle manager, and the two outsiders fall in love. But when the future of the company suddenly revolves around Viktor, he must make a choice.

The comedy is the feature debut of writer-director Christian Arhoff. This coming-of-age story portrays their different destinies in life and in art - seen through the time of the female spring. Apolonia is told over the course of 13 years; an existential voyage into the mind of three young woman's thoughts on sexuality, art, idealism and love as they live and rethink them through their twenties and thirties.

Lea Glob has co-directed the feature film: Olmo & The Seagull (2015) with Petra Costa, and Venus (2016) with Mette Carla Albrechtsen. Apolonia, Apolonia is her first feature film outside co-direction. 

CAN'T FEEL NOTHING / REMOTE CONTROL

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres estimated in 2022 that nearly 1 billion people around the world, including millions of children and young people, "have a mental health condition" and declared a global mental health crisis.

The film constructs a tapestry of human stories across four continents, depicting a dark comedic and disturbing present where our human emotions are instrumentalized with ruthless efficiency. Are we already losing human autonomy and what might happen when the emotions that make us human are mainly experienced as a way to get us to click on things?

American film director David Borenstein is based in Denmark. He is addressing issues of emotional manipulation, hyperstimulation and affective computing systems build to interpret and stimulate emotional response in the film language of cinematic documentary. It is narrated in essayistic fashion, dark and tragic, but also comedic and humanistic with surprising plot-twists.

The loss of innocence has always been associated with death. Growing up in Israel, Davidi remember observing how the spark of joy had left the eyes of the children around him. Israel is no place for the innocent souls, sensitives or idealists. An elaborate system of conventions and social rules are designed to dismantle innocence, desensitise children and groom young people for what is said to define Israeli identity and ethos, its compulsory military service. The film is the story of young people on the verge of adulthood who resisted the dismantling of their youthful innocence for the purpose of producing combat soldiers, told in the words of those who committed suicide rather than completing the military service.

Guy Davidi received international acclaim with 'Five Broken Cameras' (2011), which won for best director at Sundance in the World Cinema competition, received an Oscar nomination and won an Emmy.

The story of a film crew and a young man who travel deep into the Sri Lankan jungle to understand the mystery of his father, a renowned Danish HIV researcher who left both job and family to live as a monk in isolation for 17 years, who ended up committing suicide and leaving behind 200 hours of video material from his years in the jungle.

The documentary directors, Mira Jargil and Christian Sønderby Jepsen have created multiple award winning feature documentaries amongst others 'Reunited', 'The Will', 'Side by Side' and 'Natural Disorder'. Together they founded the production company Moving Documentary. Both are graduates from the National Film School of Denmark.

Two decades after the tragic death of his baby brother, the director Christians Einshøj's family is falling apart. When his overworked CEO dad is unexpectedly let off and decides to sell the family home, Christian goes back home in a final desperate attempt to assemble the family and recover what is lost. Armed with 30 years of home-video, 75.000 family photos and three tightly fit superhero costumes, he ventures into landscapes of long-lost time, in an attempt to confront a 25-year old tragedy, and the hidden wounds left in its wake.

It's a story of fathers and sons, of vast collections of stamps and amateur videography, of long-distance business-class flights and all the other ways in which we flee, instead of talking about that which hurts – and of the redemption that can follow when the silence is eventually breached.

Music for Black Pigeons is a cinematic improvisation piece. It's a film about being present in the now, about playing and improvising, about carrying on the heritage from generations of jazz pioneers and creating something unlike anything you've ever heard before.




RESORTS / RESORTS

At the south tip of Gran Canaria, a small Island in the Atlantic Ocean, the sun is always shining. The 60'ies pastel colored hotels and glittering swimming pools set the scene. Somewhere between the Dunas, the beach and the shopping centers, the usual holiday activities keep the tourists occupied. Meanwhile the permanent vacationers invite us to see a different side of the resort. A varied cast from Scandinavia, Europe and Africa have left their old lives behind, to get a fresh start somewhere far from home. Resorts is a human study and a visually stunning portrait of a classic charter destination that is becoming increasingly rundown, but stubbornly insists on the joy of life. Resorts offer a new look on the migration crisis and complexities of tourism.

Director Mette Carla has a strong visual profile and a conceptual approach to cinema. She often engages in portraying difficult or taboo subjects with an anthropological eye. In 2019 she won multiple awards including a Silver Lion in Cannes. Her first feature film "Venus" Co-Directed with Lea Glob premiered at iDFA.

Powerlessness comes in the form of bewilderment and restlessness as three young Russian women can no longer see a future for themselves in Russia, each seeking to navigate their path to freedom. From 2018 to 2022 the film follows the life of Alika, Alyona and Katya. In search for love, friendship, and the dream of escaping Putin's Russia, the three women struggle and despite strong wills it often turn into escapism.


In a new reality, the future of the three women has been put further under pressure and following Western sanctions, it has become even more difficult to leave Russia. At the same time, it is almost unthinkable to stay. Life in another country is challenging and soon overshadowed by the question of responsibility.

USA, January 6, 2021. US congressmen are gathered in parliament at the Capitol about to approve the election result and declare Joe Biden the winner. Less than a mile away, Donald Trump is urging the crowd to march towards the Capitol. A few hours later, 5 people are killed and 141 wounded. With Trump's political godfather, Roger Stone, as its central character, the film documents how Trump's presidential period had to find its logical endpoint with The Storm on the Capitol. The director set out to follow the 'Make America Great Again' movement and ends up a close witness to the historical events at the centre of American democracy.

Christoffer Guldbrandsen's portrayals of politicians and political events include 'The Road to Europe' (2003) about Danish Prime Minister and EU President, Anders Fogh Rasmussen, in the negotiations towards the Union's enlargement, 'The Secret War' (2006) about Denmark's military presence in Afghanistan, and 'The President' (2011) about how Europe got its first president.




Dominic Ongwen was 9 and on his way to school when he became one of the 20,000 children abducted by the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA). LRA is led by Joseph Kony, who uses mysticism and cruelty to turn children into ferocious killers, all in the name of freeing the Ugandan people from the rule of the brutal regime of Yoweri Museveni and leaving more than 100,000 dead in the process. Tortured and brutalised, Ongwen quickly learned to kill or be killed. Over 26 years, he learned to follow orders so well that he rose through the ranks. He was one of the five LRA leaders indicted for crimes against humanity by the International Criminal Court (ICC).

The lawyer Krispus Ayena has chosen to defend Ongwen. He is under immense pressure, both from his people who were victims of the conflict and from the Ugandan government itself. The film follows Dominic Ongwen's trial and tells the story of the Northern Uganda conflict.

Renowned Inuit lawyer Aaju Peter has led a lifelong fight for the rights of her people. When her son dies to suicide, Aaju embarks on a personal journey to bring her colonizers to justice. She channels her pain into writing an autobiography and takes on the difficult task of creating a permanent forum for Indigenous issues in the EU, ensuring that Indigenous people have a seat and a voice in European policy. But as tension builds, a key question arises: is it possible to change the world and yourself at the same time?

In her first feature documentary, Danish director Lin Alluna confronts her home country's dark colonial past. Co-written by its main character Aaju Peter, Twice Colonized is a brutal and brutally honest portrait of the life and work of one of the most important voices of the Arctic. And her continued fight to break free from the chains of colonization. A collaboration between Greenland, Canada, and Denmark, Twice Colonized is the first formal co-production between Inuit across colonial borders.
