THE BASTARD / BASTARDEN

In the mid-1700s, Danish King Frederik V declared that the wild heath of Jutland should be tamed, cultivated, and colonized so that civilization could spread and new taxes be generated for the throne. However, no one dared to follow the King's decree. The heath meant certain death – a godforsaken place haunted by ravenous wolves, highwaymen, and a brutal, unforgiving nature. But in the late summer of 1755, a lone soldier by the name of Ludvig Kahlen rode into the heath in stubborn pursuit of a lifelong dream, determined to reach his goal: The heath would either bring him the wealth and honour he had long sought... or get the better of him.

Writer-director Nikolaj Arcel collaborates with scriptwriter Anders Thomas Jensen ('Riders of Justice') on his first Danish-language film since his Berlin-winning and Oscar-nominated 'A Royal Affair'. Mads Mikkelsen stars alongside Amanda Collin, Kristine Kujath Thorp and Gustav Lindh. Arcel graduated from The National Film School of Denmark in 2001 and apart from directing his own films, he has written scripts for some of the biggest local box-office hits in recent years.

BEFORE IT ENDS / BEFRIELSEN


When a boarding school for young adults is turned into an internment camp for German refugees during the final months of World War II, the headmaster couple Jakob and Lis and their children are thrust into an impossible situation. Should the family help the refugees - or stand firm in the Danish resistance against the Germans?

BEFORE IT ENDS is inspired by true events and depicts a sensitive chapter in the history of Denmark: The handling of 250,000 German civil refugees who came to Denmark in the spring of 1945. The feature is a drama about a family under pressure and the limits of charity.

Writer/director Anders Walter kickstarted his career by winning an Academy Award for the short film 'Helium' in 2014. After this, he directed the American feature film 'I Kill Giants' (2017). Walter has both written and directed 'BEFORE IT ENDS', which is his first Danish feature. The main character is played by Danish actor Pilou Asbæk, known internationally for his role in 'Game of Thrones', and the oscar nominated feature 'A War'.





Tobias is not used to receiving love and attention from home, so the unfamiliar affection Aron offers is difficult to handle. Every time Aron gets close, Tobias pushes him away.

Director Søren Green holds a master's degree in Film Studies from University of Copenhagen and has directed a number of short films and a web series, before his feature debut B.O.Y. co-written with his writing partner Tomas Lagermand Lundme and is produced by Asta Film.

A young woman has disappeared without a trace. Three months later her boyfriend agrees to an unusual arrangement: to be locked in an apartment and interrogated by the woman's father. It soon becomes obvious that even long before her disappearance, the two lovers had chosen a strange and unconventional life: cut off from the world, isolated in the middle of the big city.

Skovbjerg made his debut with 'Sticks and Stones', which premiered at London Film Festival in 2018 and won a prize at the Danish Robert Awards. He became a prominent voice among the young generation with his two youth series 'Anton90' and 'Fastland'.

The film is based on the Norwegian novel 'Sander' by Terje Holtet. The screenplay is written by Eskil Vogt, who came to prominence with his collaboration with Joachim Trier.

EMPIRE / VIFTEN


The Danish West Indies, 1848. Anna and Petrine have had a sister-like friendship for years. They are both women of colour living within the Danish colonial system, but Petrine is an enslaved housekeeper and Anna is her owner. Anna is free and shares her life with the white Danish Governor General. She has made a fortune trading enslaved people while at the same time encouraging better conditions for the enslaved. Petrine wants to buy her own freedom but fears hurting Anna, as rumours of a slave riot threaten Anna's privileged position in Danish society. As with everything in this story, nothing is just black or white.

Empire is a non-traditional period piece about Denmark's relatively unknown colonial past, written by Danish-Nigerian Anna Neye and directed by Frederikke Aspöck. Like the director's previous three features, Empire examines the extreme complexity of individual characters. Her most recent film, the prison comedy-drama 'Out Of Tune' (2019), premiered in Rotterdam and became a national box-office hit.

THE IDIOT / IDIOTEN

Tobias and Cille are lovers with a troubled past, determined to turn their lives around. Tobias is out of rehab and Cille is slowly getting back to a normal life after years of mental and physical illness. The young couple is now expecting their first child but despite the happy circumstances, their unfortunate past seems to cling to them. During a rehabilitation course, Tobias discovers that he wants to become an actor. However, people around him do not approve of his newfound joy and neither do social services, who are more than familiar with Tobias and Cille. They start questioning if the young couple is at all fit for parenthood.

Writer-director Kasper Rune Larsen made his feature debut with the no-budget film 'Denmark', which screened in Generation 14Plus at the Berlinale in 2018. THE IDIOT is inspired by the director and his actors' own upbringing, life and experiences, which form the basis for the direction and the improvised acting. The main character is played by writer-musician Jacob Skyggebjerg who made his acting debut in 'Denmark'.




Based on the autobiographic award-winning novel by Danish-Norwegian author Kim Leine, KALAK deals with the relationship between Denmark and Greenland, the oppressor and the oppressed, the molester and the survivor, individualist and collectivist society. Jan, a family father and nurse, is on a selfdestructive run from himself as a victim of sexual abuse. He takes a job in Greenland where he yearns to be a part of the open, collectivist culture, but really just tries to fuck his way in. When someone calls him a Kalak, a local word meaning both a "true" and "dirty" Greenlander, he wears it as a badge of honour, but ultimately has to confront his past.

Director Isabella Eklöf co-wrote the script with the author and Sissel Dalsgaard Thomsen. She unapologetically exposes the beauty and ugliness of human nature as in her acclaimed debut 'Holiday', which premiered in Sundance. She previously co-wrote 'Border' and recently directed episodes of Apple's 'The Servant' and HBO's 'Industry'.

In the early 1950s, fifteen-year-old Cecilia has become unwillingly pregnant due to a sexual assault by the warden of the orphanage in which she grew up. To conceal the pregnancy, the orphanage decides that Cecilia is to give away her unborn child to Ida, who desperately wants to adopt, and who lives alone with her maid Alma in an old, isolated mansion. Cecilia is sent to live at the mansion for the duration of her pregnancy and for a time the three women constitute an odd family, where they each find respite for their loneliness, sorrow and longing. But with the arrival of the baby, the harmonious circumstances suddenly change. MADAME IDA is a story about longing for love and affection, and about the extreme measures to which we will go to achieve it.

Jacob Møller, a 2019 graduate from the National Film School, makes his feature debut as writer-director, which stars Flora Ofelia Lindahl Hoffmann as Cecilia, who won the Silver Shell for Best Leading Performance in 'As in Heaven' at the San Sebastian Film Festival in 2021.




Carl lives a quiet life in the countryside with his adoptive parents. His destiny is predetermined, being the only son and expected to take over his parents' farm and carry on the family's proud farming traditions. It has been this way for generations and with Carl's help it will continue. But Carl doesn't fit in and he knows he can't fulfil his parents' dream. He wants something different. As an adopted child from South Korea, Carl carries a secret longing: the wish to find his own place and his roots. Torn between two worlds, Carl must make a choice about where he belongs. The film revolves around 'ties of blood' and 'belonging and not belonging' as adoptees try to find themselves and their place in the adoptive family.

Malene Choi's feature-length debut 'The Return', also dealing with transnational adoption, premiered and received a Special Mention in Rotterdam in 2018 and went on to numerous other festivals including Gothenburg, CPH:DOX and Toronto Hot Docs. 

The creative couple Stine and Teit and their young son Nemo leave their urban life in Copenhagen behind in favour of an isolated forest in Sweden, where they hope to find themselves as individuals while documenting their new lifestyle in an ongoing podcast series. Regretfully, they realise there's another couple across the lake, who are surprisingly like themselves. Soon, old grudges and selfish desires begin to take over, forcing them to confront their own egos.

This psychological thriller deals with the fundamental split between self-realisation and being present in life. In 1998, Brazil was the first country in the world to imprison people who released hot-air balloons.






Something looms on the horizon of the tiny Danish Wadden Sea island, Mandø, with its 28 inhabitants. Climate change experts predict the warming of the ocean and the rising water level. The few remaining islanders pay no heed to these warnings. Caught up in their everyday lives they seem to be oblivious to this impending catastrophe. We meet Gregers, the island's last farmer, Ellen, who manages the smallest supermarket in Denmark, Ornithologist Niels, and Mie, getting ready for her 100th birthday. An exploration of the tension between the quotidian lives of the islanders in the face of the destructive force of the looming storm.

The islanders' oblivious attitude towards climate change doesn't come from a place of arrogance or recklessness. They know how to live from the land they inhabit and from the sea around them. The island is a reservoir of a particular knowledge about sustainably existence being in this endangered world.

Recent studies suggest a direct correlation between internet use and a broad range of emotional disorders. Some experts even consider this to be the root cause of the global mental health crisis. So, what's happening - what is the Internet doing to us? Troubled by these findings, the director sets out to find answers and the people responsible. Across four continents, he finds a disturbing present where companies and individuals use the power of the internet to remotely control our decision-making with huge emotional tolls not only on us, their targets, but also on themselves. From emotion AI companies that claim to be able to stimulate any emotion in a human subject, to trolls in the US that harness the power of anger, to Chinese live-streamers that study how to make their viewers fall in love, and Russian TikTok propagandists who strive to make Russian people take pride in the war in Ukraine.

DAUGHTER OF GENGHIS / DAUGHTER OF GENGHIS

The story of Gerel, a violent neo-nationalist, who wants to protect her country against foreign dominance and exploitation. For thousands of years the Mongols and Chinese have been enemies, and today the proudly nomadic Mongolia is a poverty stricken country, with 3 million people surrounded by China and Russia. We follow Gerel and her son Temuleen for 7 years, charting the dramatic changes in their life. In the beginning she raids brothels and gambling dens with her gang of women. She is fueled by a desire to change society, but Gerel's activism leads to neglect of her own son. She realizes that her hatred is connected to her own personal traumas. Gerel must revisit everything she holds dear to learn how to be a caring mother to her son.

All across the globe the far right is on the rise, and we want to understand it's attraction. Mining by foreign companies dominate the Mongolian economy, and urban life has largely replaced the nomadic horse culture. This story exposes the challenges a globalized modern economy poses to vulnerable indigenous populations, and how hatred and violence has roots in personal trauma.




THE END OF QUIET / THE END OF QUIET

In a remote rural community in West Virginia, a powerful radio telescope is listening into space to unlock the mysteries of the universe. Meanwhile, living in the quietest place on earth with no cell phones or WI-FI, the locals are faced with the mysteries of life itself. THE END OF QUIET digs deep into what seemingly is a simpler and less hectic and demanding life than the world most of us live in. The absence of wireless communication, social media and entertainment on demand seemingly paints a utopian picture that will resonate with the audience. However, things are never that simple and the grass is not always greener on the other side.

Both directors graduated from the National Film School in Lodz and have a long list of both documentaries and short fictions to their names. The film is a unique three-year-long collaboration between the directors and the internationally acclaimed editor Charlotte Munch Bengtsen. She recently edited the Oscar-nominated 'All that Breathes' and the multiple award-winning box-office-hit, 'The Truffle Hunters'.

The artwork 'Peace Sculpture' created by artist Elle-Mie Ejdrup for the commemoration of Denmark's liberation of the Nazi occupation on May 4, 1995. It was Denmark's largest work of art and sparked a historic controversy. The artwork, which involved a 532 km long laser beam along the bunkers on the west coast, triggered a heated national debate among former resistance fighters, politicians, and the Danish press regarding the dark past of the country. The controversy became so intense that the artist and her team received death threats, rape threats, and human feces by post. The scandal, fueled by sexist media coverage portraying Elle-Mie as incompetent, led her to be ostracized from the Danish art world for two decades. LYSET is a unique perspective on history and provides a platform for voices that have been marginalized and ignored for far too long.

Alexander Lind graduated from The National Danish Film School in 2013 with his documentary film 'Carl & Niels', which was selected for IDFA and won "Best New Nordic Voice" at Nordisk Panorama.

An existential investigation, a spiritual mystery, and a moving family drama. THE MONK sifts through questions of identity, transcendence, and the pursuit of happiness.

The story of a film crew and a young man who travel deep into the Sri Lankan jungle to understand the mystery of his father, a renowned Danish HIV researcher who left both job and family to live as a monk in isolation for 17 years, who ended up committing suicide and leaving behind 200 hours of video material from his years in the jungle.

The documentary directors, Mira Jargil and Christian Sønderby Jepsen have created multiple award-winning feature documentaries, amongst others 'Reunited', 'The Will', 'Side by Side' and 'Natural Disorder'. Together they founded the production company Moving Documentary. Both are graduates from the National Film School of Denmark.


Two decades after the tragic death of his baby brother, director Christians Einshøj's family is falling apart. When his overworked CEO dad is unexpectedly let off and decides to sell the family home, Christian goes back home in a final, desperate attempt to assemble the family and recover what is lost. Armed with 30 years of home-video, 75.000 family photos and three tightly fit superhero costumes, he ventures into landscapes of long-lost time, in an attempt to confront a 25-year old tragedy, and the hidden wounds left in its wake.

THE MOUNTAINS is a story of fathers and sons, of vast collections of stamps and amateur videography, of long-distance business-class flights and all the other ways in which we flee, instead of talking about what hurts – and of the redemption that can follow when the silence is eventually breached.

THE MOUNTAINS won Best International Feature Award at Hot Docs 2023.


The film explores the landscape inhabited by Susie and Sune and the nature that inhabits them. Is siblinghood enough? Or is it too much?

SILENT SUN OF RUSSIA / VI ER RUSLAND


Powerlessness comes in the form of bewilderment and restlessness as three young Russian women can no longer see a future for themselves in Russia, each seeking to navigate their path to freedom. From 2018 to 2022 the film follows the life of Alika, Alyona and Katya. In search for love, friendship, and the dream of escaping Putin's Russia, the three women struggle and despite strong wills often turn to escapism.

In a new reality, the future of the three women has been put further under pressure and following Western sanctions, it has become even more difficult to leave Russia. At the same time, it is almost unthinkable to stay. Life in another country is challenging and soon overshadowed by the question of responsibility.

Sybilla Tuxen is a documentary film director and photographer; she graduated from The National Film School of Denmark (2017). In 2011 she moved to St. Petersburg where she studied Russian at university. SILENT SUN OF RUSSIA is her feature documentary debut.

USA, January 6, 2021. US congressmen are gathered in parliament at the Capitol about to approve the election result and declare Joe Biden the winner. Less than a mile away, Donald Trump is urging the crowd to march towards the Capitol. A few hours later, five people are killed and 141 wounded. With Trump's political godfather, Roger Stone, as its central character, A STORM FORETOLD documents how Trump's presidential period had to find its logical endpoint with The Storm on the Capitol. The director set out to follow the 'Make America Great Again' movement and ends up a close witness to the historical events at the centre of American democracy.

Christoffer Guldbrandsen's portrayals of politicians and political events include 'The Road to Europe' (2003) about Danish Prime Minister and EU President, Anders Fogh Rasmussen, in the negotiations towards the EU's expansion, 'The Secret War' (2006) about Denmark's military presence in Afghanistan, and 'The President' (2011) about how Europe got its first president.




Dominic Ongwen was 9 and on his way to school when he became one of the 20,000 children abducted by the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA). LRA is led by Joseph Kony, who uses mysticism and cruelty to turn children into ferocious killers, all in the name of freeing the Ugandan people from the rule of the brutal regime of Yoweri Museveni and leaving more than 100,000 dead in the process. Tortured and brutalised, Ongwen quickly learned to kill or be killed. Over the course of 26 years, he learned to follow orders so well that he rose through the ranks. He was one of the five LRA leaders indicted for crimes against humanity by the International Criminal Court (ICC).

The lawyer Krispus Ayena has chosen to defend Ongwen. He is under immense pressure, both from his people who were victims of the conflict and from the Ugandan government itself. The film follows Dominic Ongwen's trial and tells the story of the Northern Uganda conflict.


Renowned Inuit lawyer Aaju Peter has led a lifelong fight for the rights of her people. When her son dies to suicide, Aaju embarks on a personal journey to bring her colonizers to justice. She channels her pain into writing an autobiography and takes on the difficult task of creating a permanent forum for Indigenous issues in the EU, ensuring that Indigenous people have a seat and a voice in European policy. But as tension builds, a key question arises: is it possible to change the world and yourself at the same time?

In her first feature documentary, Danish director Lin Alluna confronts her home country's dark colonial past. Co-written by its protagonist Aaju Peter, Twice Colonized is a brutal and brutally honest portrait of the life and work of one of the most important voices of the Arctic, and her continued fight to break free from the chains of colonization. A collaboration between Greenland, Canada, and Denmark, Twice Colonized is the first formal co-production between Inuit across colonial borders.
