Anna is visited by a small yellow aeroplane named Zanzibar along with its crew: Captain Bimse and the co-pilot Goggeletten. With her trusted teddy bear Mr. Johnson in tow, Anna embarks on a magical rescue mission with Captain Bimse and Goggeletten to save Sophie.

Aimed at children aged three to seven, the film is an adaptation of a children's book by Bjarne Reuter, mixing live action, puppets and animated backgrounds. The two co-directors both have a background in animation and visual effects. Their credits include 'Jewel of the Desert' (2001) and 'Sunshine Barry & the Disco Worms' (2008), both of which Nielsen directed.

They put their lives and bodies in each other's hands to survive the heat, pressure and mud in the claustrophobic cutterhead, exposing their radically different world views and forcing them to reconsider their lives — before finally being rescued.

Daniel is ever more desperate to come back to his family back home in Denmark.

The film is based on a bestselling book by Danish journalist Puk Damgård and tells the true story of one of the most spectacular hostage-takings in recent times. Oplev directed the 2009 original Swedish version of 'The Girl with the Dragon Tattoo.' 

Parallel to his studies, he works on a visionary energy project based on wind and wave energy, a project so much ahead of its time, that his professors consider him insane and far too self-confident. However, Per's project becomes a success and he gets engaged to the beautiful Jakobe who is a part of a wealthy Jewish family. One would imagine that Per's happiness now is made. But his childhood keeps haunting him and his dogmatic family cannot accept his new life. In 1961, United Nations secretary-general Dag Hammarskjöld's plane mysteriously crashed, leaving no known survivors. It is widely understood that because Hammarskjöld was, at the time, advocating for Congo's independence (against the wishes of European mining companies and other powerful entities), the "crash" was an assassination. With the case still unsolved 50-plus years later, Danish journalist, filmmaker and provocateur Mads Brügger leads an investigation to unearth the truth. Brügger, his Swedish private-investigator sidekick Göran Björkdahl and a host of co-conspirators tirelessly pursue a winding trail of clues, but they turn up more mysteries than revelations. Scores of false starts, dead ends and elusive interviews later, they begin to sniff out something more monumental than anything they had initially imagined.
