

ACTS OF LOVE / KÆRLIGHEDENS GERNINGER Hanna longs to have a child and hopes that her simple life in a Christian cult will help her achieve her greatest dream. But Hanna's orderly life with the cult is disrupted when her younger brother arrives and their shared secret starts to unravel. Will this threaten Hanna's dream of becoming a mother? And will the community start toquestion their own religious beliefs and what kinds of love are acceptable?

Director Jeppe Rønde (b. 1973) has explored faith within different religions in both his documentaries 'Jerusalem My Love' (2003) and 'The Swenkas' (2004). Both premiered at IDFA and the latter secured a nomination for European Film Awards and the Danish Film Award. Rønde's debut fiction feature film, 'Bridgend', about a mysteriousoutbreak of teen suicides in a small village in Wales, premiered at Rotterdam in The Tiger Competition in 2015 and later picked up awards at the Tribeca, Gøteborg, Fantasia and Fantasporto film festivals. Rønde has also won acclaim for his extensive work in commercials.



In the hope of creating a better life, 6-year-old Maja and her parents leave Yugoslavia for Denmark, leaving behind Maja's two older brothers with the promise they will join once the family is settled. But the new country proves difficult and unfamiliar, and the family struggles to adapt to a new language, culture, and way of life. As the years pass, Maja grows up and becomes a successful artist in Denmark, yet beneath her achievements, she carries a divide of joy, sorrow, and gratitude—torn between the life she has built and the painful sacrifices her parents made for their future.

HOME marks the feature film debut for director and acclaimed Danish actress Marijana Jankovich, born in Montenegro. She graduated from the Danish National School of Performing Arts in 2006. In 2018 she made her debut as a screenwriter and director with the short film 'Maja', which was inspired by her own childhood. The short film won 'Best Narrative Short Film at the Tribeca Film Festival in 2019, as well as 'Best Danish Short Film' at the Odense Film Festival (OFF) in 2018.

He is at peace with things as they are, and even when everyone is chasing a better future somewhere else, Kári decides to stay and face the challenges head-on. Because for him, his hometown is The Last Paradise on Earth.

Sakaris Frídi Stórá (b.1986) is born and raised on the Faroe Islands. In 2007 he moved to Norway to study film at Nordland College of Art and Film. After graduating he moved back to the Faroe Islands to work as a screenwriter and director, and to pursue his ambitions of giving the Faroese language and culture a place in film history. Stóra made his feature debut with the drama 'Dreams by the Sea' (2017), which also took place on the Faroe Islands and was screened at a number of Nordic film festivals.





Set 4000 years BC, this pre-historical survival drama follows the young woman Aathi and her family arriving as the first farmers ever to what is now known as Denmark. However, shortly after they clash with a local tribe of hunter-gatherers, and soon Aathi and her brother are forced to live with the tribe who killed most of their family and learn their traditions in order to survive. Gradually, the demands Aathi must submit to become more and more ruthless and the film becomes a nervewracking drama about revenge and forgiveness. It is also a unique look into the transition from hunter to peasant stone-age with a Pre-Indo-European language developed for the film.

Director Mads Hedegaard (b.1982) graduated from the National Film School of Denmark in 2017 and his debut documentary 'Cannon Arm and the Arcade Quest' premiered at CPH:DOX and Hot Docs in 2021. This is Mads Hedegaard's fiction feature debut, and he co-wrote the script with Jesper Fink ('Before the frost', 'Birthday Girl').







Pasha is an unlikely hero—a beloved Russian primary school teacher, known as a mentor and prankster who offers students a safe haven in his office. After Russia invades Ukraine, his role changes as he is drawn into Putin's propaganda machine. Forced to promote state-sanctioned messages and horrified by the transformation of his school and community, he struggles with guilt and a sense of powerlessness, leading him to become an international whistleblower. As the school's videographer, Pasha documents intimate and revealing footage, capturing the rise of militarized children's groups, repressive laws, fervent nationalism, and the recruitment of graduating students to fight in the war. When he learns his own life may be at risk, he is forced to plan his escape from Russia.

Copenhagen-based American-born director David Borenstein ('Can't Feel Nothing') co-directed this uniquely collaborative film with Pasha Talankin revealing the profound impact of Putin's regime on the lives of everyday Russians, particularly its children.
